CRITERIA & GUIDELINES

ABOUT THE CLUB'S HALL OF FAME

St Peter's Hall of Fame was established in 2001. The Hall of Fame recognises and honours Club members who have made significant contributions to the life of the Club and the local Community and is the most prestigious award the Club can bestow on an individual. The Hall of Fame therefore acknowledges the contributions and accomplishments of individuals who are worthy of recognition and examples for others to emulate.

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

In order to be considered for this prestigious award, the nominee must have given continuous service to St Peter's Club, on and/or off the field, for at least twenty years and meets one or more of the following criteria:

- Demonstrated long-standing service and high achievement as a player, manager, coach or referee;
- Significant contribution as a volunteer/administrator at Club and County, Provincial or National level;
- Demonstrated high achievement in the cultural aspects of the GAA (Scór etc);
- Significant contribution to the Club and local community through volunteering or charitable contributions.

GUIDELINES

St Peter's GAA Club standard nomination form must be used in nominating a Club member.

The nominator must provide contact information of the nominee or his/her closest living relatives or friends. Posthumous nominations will be considered.

Nominations will not be made public.

All nominations and associated information will become the property of St Peter's GAA Club. Nominations will not be returned to the nominator.



Nominations will be accepted no later than four weeks before the date set for the annual dinner.

Nominations can be submitted by obtaining a Nomination Pack from the Secretary of the Hall of Fame Committee and mailing the nomination form to the Secretary of the Hall of Fame Committee. The nomination form is also available on-line at www.stpetersgac.com.

Having considered the nominations, the Hall of Fame Committee is responsible for putting their recommendation to the Club's Executive Committee. In the event of there being no suitable nomination(s), the Hall of Fame will submit a NIL recommendation. The Executive Committee will make the final decision.

In the event of a member of the Hall of Fame Committee or the Executive Committee being nominated, the said person will not take part in the decision-making process for that year. Should this happen, the Executive Committee will appoint a substitute to the relevant Committee.

Where appropriate, the nominee's family or friends will be contacted to give consent for consideration and verify information on the nomination form.

An official announcement will be made at the annual dinner when the honouree will be officially recognised. In the event of there being no nomination approved by the Executive Committee, no announcement will be made. Nominations for the year ahead will open immediately after the annual dinner.

The Executive Committee has the discretion to carry forward recommended nominees from one year to the next, subject to the agreement of the nominator, and the nominee's family/friends if deemed appropriate.

The Hall of Fame Committee is responsible for researching and developing a pool of potential nominees; maintaining the Hall of Fame plaque; and updating the Hall of Fame nomination pack.
